RESOLUTION NO. 719-89

SETTING DATE FOR PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED LOCAL LAW

Mr. Colvin presented the following:

RESOLVED, pursuant to Section 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, that the Board of Supervisors shall hold a public hearing at 7:00 p.m. on December 4, 1989, in the Supervisors' Chambers in the County Court House, 26 Church Street, Lyons, New York on the following proposed local law:

A local law authorizing the sale or lease of County real property without public advertisement or competitive bidding, superseding the provisions of subdivision 6 of Section 215 of the County Law.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAYNE, as follows:

Section 1.

Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision 6 of Section 215 of the County Law of the State of New York, real property owned by the County of Wayne may be sold or leased upon such manner as may be determined by resolution of the Board of Supervisors, without public advertisement or competitive bidding.

Section 2.

This local law is subject to a permissive referendum and the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall give public notice hereof in the manner provided by law.

Section 3.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon the date it is filed in the Office of the Secretary of State in accordance with the provisions of Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Board of Supervisor is hereby directed to give at least five days notice of such hearing by posting such notice upon the bulletin board at the County Court House, Lyons, New York and by publishing such notice at least once in the official newspapers of the County.

Mr. Healy moved the adoption of the resolution. Seconded by Mr. DeAngelis. Upon roll call, all Supervisors voted Aye. Absent - Supervisors Mogray and Wheeler. The Chairman declared the resolution adopted.

NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW SUBJECT
TO PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a local law authorizing the sale or lease of county real property without public advertisement or competitive bidding, superseding the provisions of subdivision 6 of Section 215 of the County Law, was duly adopted by the Wayne County Board of Supervisors on December 4, 1989.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that said local law is subject to a permissive referendum of the qualified electors of the County of Wayne. Such referendum may be required by the filing of a petition protesting against such local law signed and authenticated as required by Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York by qualified electors of Wayne County registered to vote therein at the last preceding general election, in number equal to at least ten percentum (10%) of the total number of votes cast for Governor at the last gubernatorial election in the County. The petition must be filed with the undersigned Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Wayne at her office in the County Court House, 26 Church Street, Lyons, New York 14889, within forty-five (45) days from the date of adoption of the local law by the Board of Supervisors.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAYNE, as follows:
