Local Law No. 2 of the year 19 73

A local law providing for an exemption from taxation and special ad valorem levies

imposed by the County for County and Part County Purposes.

Be it enacted by the WAYNE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS of the

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 485 of the Real Property Law of the State of New York eligible business facilities as defined in Section 115 of the Commerce Law of the State of New York which are located within the County of Wayne shall be exempt from taxes and special ad valorem levies imposed by or on behalf of the County of Wayne for County and Part-County purposes in accordance with the following schedule for exemption.

- 100% exemption for each of first five years
- 90% exemption for the sixth year
- 80% exemption for the seventh year
- 60% exemption for the eighth year
- 40% exemption for the ninth year
- 20% exemption for the tenth year

Such exemption shall be granted only upon an application by the owner or operator of such facility on a form prescribed by the New York State Job Incentive Board, to which there shall be attached a copy of a certificate of eligibility issued by the aforesaid Job Incentive Board and the exemption shall be continued from year to year during such period only if the certificate of eligibility with respect to such business facility is not revoked or modified and is renewed or extended as provided in Section 120 of the Commerce Law of the State of New York.

Section 2. If an exemption has once been granted for a business facility under this section and the assessors receive notice that a Certificate of Eligibility of such facility has been revoked or modified, they shall redetermine the assessed value of any such exemption in accordance with such revocation or modification. If upon such redetermination it appears for a year for which an exemption has been granted that such facility has been ineligible or that the assessed value of such exemption as redetermined is less than the assess value of such exemption as shown on the assessment rolls for such year, then a tax shall be levied at the rate of tax for such year upon so much of the assessed valuation of such exemption, as shown on such assessment rolls, as may be ineligible or excessive. Such tax shall be levied as an omitted assessment in the manner provided in Section 550 of the Real Property Tax Law.

Section 3. This local law is subject to a permissive resolution and in the event that a timely and lawful petition is not filed same shall take effect July 1, 1973.
