DATES AND SIGNATURE REQUIREMENTS MAY CHANGE

April 18	First day for signing Independent Petitions
May 23-30	Dates for filing Independent Petitions
June 2	Last day to accept or decline Independent Nomination
June 5	Last day to fill vacancy after declination Signatures needed for Independent Petitions is 5% of the total number of votes cast at the last gubernatorial election. County Court Judge needs 1685 signatures.

In the Towns of Macedon, Marion, Savannah, and the Town and Villages of Sodus and Sodus Point, the Republicans as well as the Town of Ontario Democratic Party, have opted to nominate through the petition process instead of the caucus process. These candidates would pass Designating Petitions. Call for further information.

Caucus

Feb 28	First day to hold town or village caucus
July 26	Last day to hold a town or village caucus
July 27	Last day to file Certificate of Nomination made at a caucus
July 31	Last day to accept or decline a nomination
July 31	Last day to file authorization
Aug 4	Last day to fill a vacancy after a declination from caucus

Please remember that a list of caucus participants needs to be filed with the Certificate of Nomination for the village only. A person can register the day of the caucus to participate and vote only if of the party having the caucus. Call our office for more information.

Caucus Notices Must Be:

Filed and posted in the Town/Village Clerk's Office and the Board of Elections at least TEN DAYS before the day of the caucus.

AND

1. Posted in newspaper publication once within the town/village at least one week and not more than two weeks preceding the caucus

OR

2. By posting in ten public places in the town or six public places within the village at least ten days preceding the caucus.

*Failure to comply with the above would make nominations null and void.

Independent Petitions for Town & Village

- Apr 18 First day to sign independent petition
- May 23-30 Dates for filing independent petitions
- June 2 Last day to accept or decline nomination
- June 5 Last day to fill a vacancy after declination

Signature requirements for Independent Petitions for Town only is 5% of the total number of votes, excluding the blank and void, cast for the office of governor at the last gubernatorial election. Please see enclosed for the signatures needed on town independent petitions.

Village Signatures Needed for Independent Petitions

Village of Newark	100 Signatures
Village of Clyde	50 Signatures
Village of Palmyra	75 Signatures
Village of Sodus	50 Signatures
Village of Sodus Point	34 Signatures
Village of Red Creek	14 Signatures

Village & Town Independent Petitions are different. The number of signatures for a village is based on population at the last census or election.

Make sure you have the correct Town or Village Petition form.

Primary Election – Tuesday, June 27, 2023

Polls open at 6 AM and close at 9 PM

- May 3 State Certification of Primary Ballot
- May 4 County Certification of Primary Ballot
- June 17 A registration form must be received by the Board of Elections to be eligible to vote in the Primary.
- June 12 Last day for the Board of Elections to receive a change of address within NY State
- June 17-25 Early Voting will be at the Board of Election's Office and Ontario Town Hall

Absentee Voters for Primary

- June 12 Last day for BOE to receive application or letter by mail or online portal for ballot
- June 26 Last day to apply in person for ballot
- June 27 Last day to postmark ballot. Must be received by the BOE no later than July 4th
- June 27 Last day to deliver primary ballot in person to your county board or poll site, by the close of polls

GENERAL ELECTION – Tuesday, November 7, 2023

Polls open at 6 AM and close at 9 PM

- Sept 13 State Certification of ballot for General
- Sept 14 County Certification of ballot for General
- Oct 28 VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE. Last day registration must be received by the Board of Elections.
- Oct 23 Last day for Board to receive a change of address within NY State
- Oct 28- Nov 5 Early Voting at the Board of Election’s Office and Ontario Town Hall

Absentee Voters for General Election

- Oct 23 Last day to for BOE to receive absentee application or letter by mail or online portal
- Nov 6 Last day to apply in person for absentee ballot
- Nov 7 Last day to postmark absentee ballot. We must receive ballot no later than November 14th
- Nov 7 Last day to deliver General Election ballot in person to your county board or poll site, by the close of polls
